

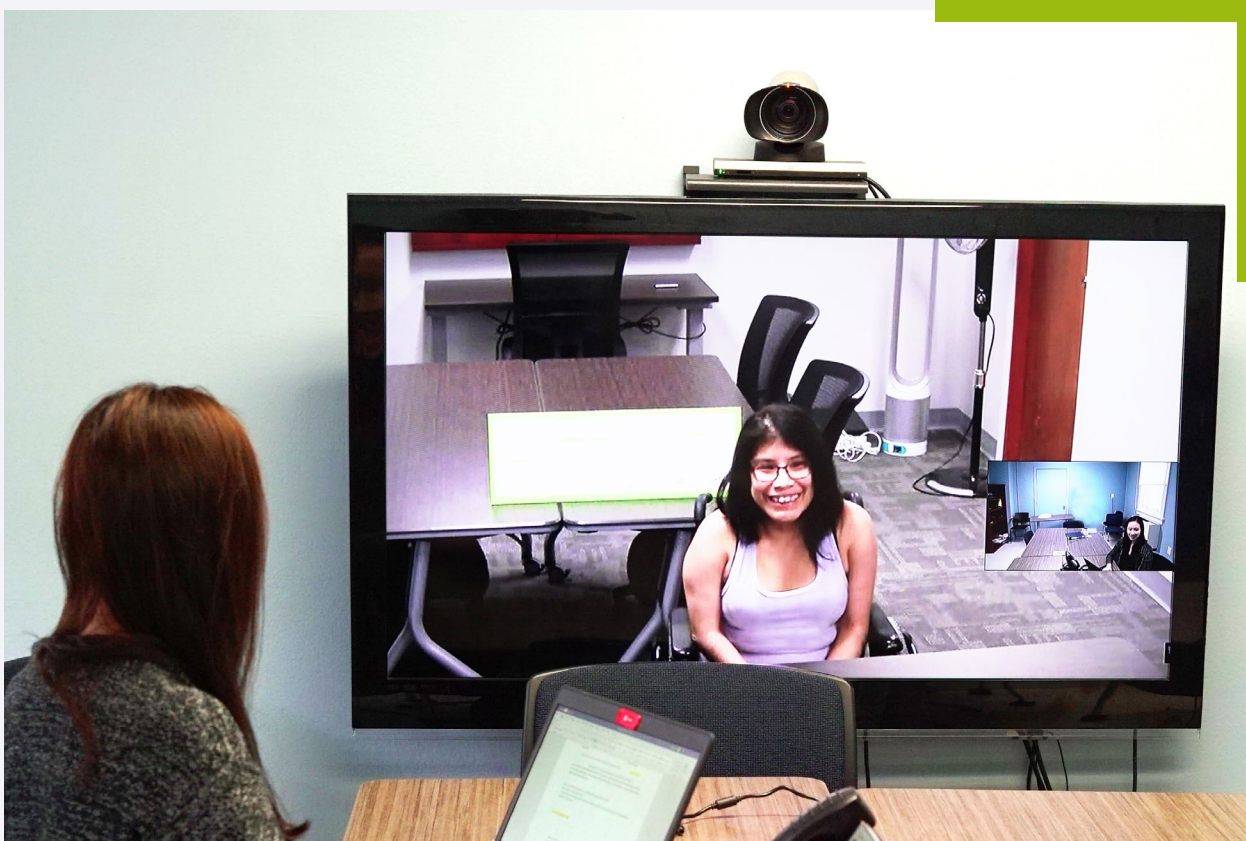


# Mashkikiwininiwag Mazinaatesijigan Wichiiwewin *Clinical Videoconferencing Program*

- › Intake and Service Coordination
- › Behaviour Consultation and Therapy
- › Counselling
- › Psychiatric Consultation and Assessment
- › Psychological Consultation and Assessment (may include diagnosis of Autism, FASD, developmental disability, memory problems/dementia, or mental health diagnoses such as depression or anxiety)
- › Educational, Social and Therapeutic Groups (i.e. Healthy Living, Self Help, Internet Safety, Mindfulness)

Our clinical service team includes Psychiatrists, Psychologists, Behaviour Therapists and Clinical Regional Access Coordinators.

We also provide education and training workshops to clients, caregivers and professionals on a variety of topics (e.g., developmental disabilities, autism, FASD, dementia, behaviour, trauma, wellness).
